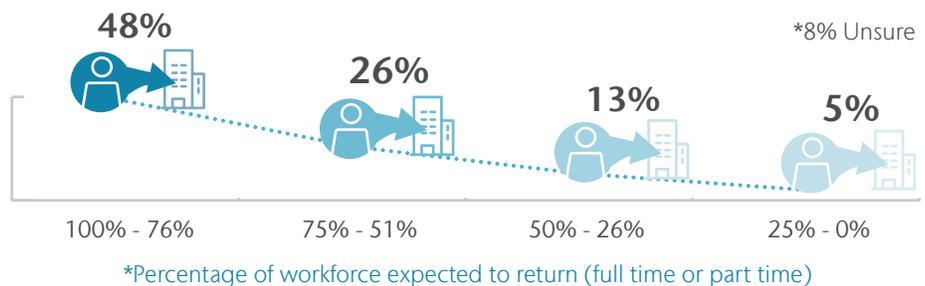

Percentage of companies that expect to return the following portion of employees back to the office once the pandemic is over

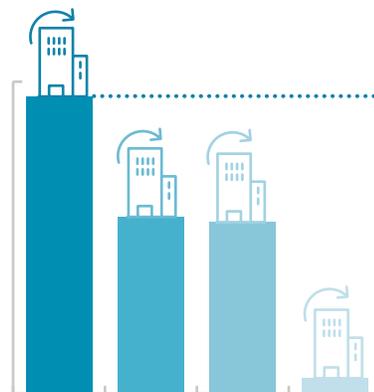


What Determining Factors Are Influencing Your Decisions?
